WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF CHIC?

There's nothing like CHIC! CHIC is the only event that gathers students from across the Evangelical Covenant Church in one place for a time of worship, transformation, and fun. CHIC acts as a catalyst in students' lives, helping them see the big picture of God's kingdom and inspiring them to dive deeper in their faith together.

WHO MAY ATTEND CHIC?

High school students are eligible to attend CHIC if they will complete grade 9, 10, 11, or 12 in the 2017-2018 school year. In order to attend CHIC 2018, students must be 15 years old by December 31st, 2017, OR be 14 years old AND have completed grade 9 in the 2017-2018 school year. Seniors may attend CHIC a second time.

Volunteers must be out of high school for at least 1 year. Counselors must be older than 21 years by September 1, 2017.

HOW AM I GOING TO PAY FOR IT?

Limited scholarships are available. Applications will be available for download at chicconference.org beginning November 1, 2017.

Please contact your CHIC liaison or ethnic pastoral association president (list on back) to apply for scholarships. A limited number of scholarships are available. Not all requests will be granted.

Scholarships will be awarded by January 15, 2018. If your group has been awarded a scholarship, you will receive a paper voucher. Each voucher is numbered and cannot be duplicated or transferred. Vouchers will be credited to the group's account before the final balance is paid.

HOW DO WE GET TO TENNESSEE AND TO THE UNIVERSITY OF TENNESSEE CAMPUS?

Every church is responsible for getting their students and leaders to CHIC. For groups who will be flying to CHIC, Transportation to and from Knoxville's McGhee Tyson Airport (TYS) is included in your registration fee. Transportation to and from Nashville's International Airport (BNA) or Atlanta's Hartsfield International Airport (ATL) is an additional fee per person round trip.
